In 2024, Friends of West Susitna (FoWSu) successfully launched a public awareness campaign through positive radio and Facebook ads, resulting in significant community engagement.

****Key Achievements:****

- ****Snow Machine Trail****: Secured a federal grant to build a 44-mile snow machine trail from the Susitna River to the Skwentna River, enhancing safety and reducing travel distance. Community response has been very positive.

- ****Support for DOT****: Advocated for the construction of 22 miles of road and a bridge across the Susitna River through targeted advertising.

- ****Grant Applications****: Applied for several grants to improve local winter trails and enhance grooming and marking efforts.

- ****Denali Commission Grant****: Received a two-year grant to mark and groom trails in various communities, ensuring safe access to essential services.

- ****Local Economy Support****: Committed to hiring local Alaskan Individuals / contractors for development and maintenance of projects, focusing on local job creation and responsible resource development.
